**HOCKMIRA London Walk Saturday 6 September** - A 5 mile walk from Islington to the Olympic Park, mainly following the route of the Regent's Canal. We shall catch a bus from Liverpool Street to Angel, Islington and walk by the canal (after a coffee stop) as far as Victoria Park (lunch spot), then continue alongside the Hertford Canal as far as the River Lee Navigation where we enter the Olympic Park (good place for tea) and eventually proceed to Stratford Station for the return to Hockley. A picnic lunch is recommended but there are two cafes in Victoria Park. The route is flat all the way, apart from a slight hill up to the Olympic Park and two or three flights of stairs. Any normal footwear will be fine, other than flip-flops or high heels. Meet at Hockley Station at 9.30am. Bring a Senior Railcard and a Bus Pass if you have them; the rail fare is £10.05. If you have no bus pass you will need a Travel Card. For those without a Railcard, the fare is still £10.05 for a group of 3 to 9 passengers.
