Do you know the price of Citizenship? An estimated 120,000 children in the UK have neither British citizenship nor immigration permission to be here. Over half were born in the UK and many are entitled to register as British citizens but are prevented from doing so by the charging of a prohibitive, profit-making fee. The government charges children £973 to apply (making a £587 profit on every application) Amnesty is calling for the removal of the profit-making aspect of the fee and other changes. If you think this fee is unfair please sign the petition at the back of church.
